Meaningful Watershed Educational Experiences: The "Chesapeake Bay Watershed Agreement" (signed 4.24.2015) is supported by VA DEQ, DC DOEE, NOAA, VA SWCD, and The National Park Service, to name a few agencies besides the VA DOE. Through a Project WET Workshop, school teams consisting of at least one administrator + two staff members, will receive **MeWEE** professional development and resources. Project WET is a nationally developed, supplementary water education program for educators, designed to teach students *how* to think, rather than *what* to think. Special emphasis is given to understanding the needs for water by all water users-no matter the geography of the district/region. (Workshop partially funded by VRUEC grant)
