

### **Tuition discounts are now available!**

#### FOR VIRGINIA EDUCATORS

- Available to Virginia residents who work in PreK-12 Virginia schools as a teacher, counselor, administrator, librarian, or staff member.
- This discount is 15% and is applied to the university's approved rate for in-state graduate students. Go to studentaccounts.gmu.edu for current rate information.
- You'll need to submit a short online application each semester. Note: students in contract cohorts need not apply for this discount as their costs are always the lowest.
