Please consider joining your area's 2016-2017 **Childhood Obesity Prevention Learning Collaborative!**

The Learning Collaborative provides training and equipment to help early learning programs improve nutrition and physical activity routines, and learn **best practices** recommended by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) to prevent childhood obesity. A total of fifty ECE programs in the Northern Virginia region will be selected to participate in this grant-funded project.

Participating ECE programs will designate a Leadership Team to represent their program and participate in one of the two NOVA collaboratives (see below). Leadership Teams **must** include a Program Director, Assistant Director, or Owner. Leadership Teams will share materials and key health concepts with program staff, and lead development of two program Action Plans for Healthy Changes.

Leadership Teams must send representation to five training sessions. Sessions run from 9:00 – 3:00, and include lunch and free materials for use with children. Learning Collaborative trainers will schedule on-site visits with Leadership Teams to provide resources and technical assistance. Program benefits, including a **\$500** stipend are listed on the <u>Information Overview</u> sheet (other page).
